The KOCSEA Technical Symposium 2014 was held at IBM T.J. Watson Research Center in Yorktown Heights, New York, December 11 -12, 2014.

The program included two keynotes (Dr. Giovanni Pacifici, IBM, Vice President, Cloud Platform and Services and Prof. Sang H. Son, DGIST, Korea), 23 technical talks, 3 industry talks, 8 lightning talks, 3 student posters, and a KOCSEA business meeting. We also hosted a tour of IBM Watson Jeopardy System and ThinkLab Tour.
